SCENE 3: Romeo, Juliet

ROMEO: Hello. (HE stands staring at her in adoration.)

JULIET: Hello. (SHE stands staring at him also in adoration.)

ROMEO: I'm Romeo.

JULIET: Juliet.

ROMEO: (Still staring.) I just had to say that I think you are the most beautiful woman that I've

ever seen.

JULIET: (Still staring. Flirtatiously.) I bet you say that to all the girls.

ROMEO: No. Only those I fall in love with. It feels like I've known you all my life.

JULIET: **(Pause.)** Me, too. It's as if I've been waiting just for this moment.

ROMEO: (Looking round.) Are you with anyone?

JULIET: No. (ROMEO sighs with relief.) It's my Mum and Dad's party.

ROMEO: I don't believe it! You mean your parents are Lord and Lady Capulet?

JULIET: Yes, why? What's the problem?

ROMEO: My Mum and Dad are Lord and Lady Montague. THAT'S the problem! (THEY both

pause.)

JULIET: What shall we do?

ROMEO: I've got to see you again, Juliet. We'll have to meet each other in secret.

JULIET: Meet me outside the house after the party.

ROMEO: Will you be okay getting out?

JULIET: Yeah. I'll sneak away later when they think I'm in bed. Wait for me, won't you?

ROMEO: (Seriously.) Forever. (HE looks around, then blows her kisses as he starts to walk

away.)
